1. Awards Committee:

This committee assists with reviewing (via email) all nominees for various WRAP Awards as well as assist as needed at the Conference Awards Banquet.

2. Bylaws Committee:

This Committee reviews the Bylaws as needed. This is done all via email.

3. Conference Committee:

This Committee is led by the Conference Chair and oversees the following Chairs: Vendor, Registration, Speaker and Local Arrangements. If you are interested in shadowing and finding out more about these, please let us know.

4. Cultural Arts Committee:

Committee members help during the WRAP Conference on registering items for the Cultural Arts, arranging projects on the display tables, and help during the judging of the projects.

5. Education Committee:

The Education Chair maintains the WRAP Lending Library as well as informs the membership of Educational opportunities. Committee members would assist making recommendations and also promote the Lending Library at the Annual Conference.

6. Government Relations Committee:

This committee monitors CMS rule changes, legislative action, and industry trends that affect the long-term care industry and the provision of activity services. This committee monitors professional websites & publications, attends conferences, is active on committees, and may be involved in advocating for our membership on issues of interest to the WRAP board & membership. This committee provides a "Government Relations & Legislative Update" session each year at WRAP's Annual State Conference.

7. Membership Committee:

Committee members will assist in renewals, mailing prep, and keeping membership records updated.

8. Communication Committee:

This committee works to gather articles of interest or of educational value in order to post on the WRAP website and Facebook page. This committee also works to find businesses who would be interested in advertising in our *WRAPping It Up* Newsletter. This committee is responsible for coming up with new and innovative ways to provide information to our members.

9. Professional Networking Committee:

This committee forms and maintains relationships with associations and organizations designated by the WRAP Board. PN recruits WRAP members to attend or exhibit at conferences or other events sponsored by organizations with which WRAP has a relationship. They are asked to report back on events attended, submitting articles to the WRAP website as appropriate.

10. <u>Scholarship Committee</u>:

Committee members review scholarship applications and select recipients. Communication for this committee is done on an as needed basis two times a year via e-mail.
